

Glenn Rollans – President



Veteran book publisher Glenn Rollans now co-owns Brush Education, a higher education publisher specializing in medical and health sciences resources. Before Brush, he has had a long and varied career in publishing, starting as a freelance writer and editor, then Editor-in-Chief at Lone Pine, Director of the U of A Press, partner in Les Éditions Duval/Duval House Publishing, and General Manager at Thomson Duval. Along the way, he has devoted lots of time to publisher education, including past stints co-directing the Business of Publishing program at the University of Chicago, and directing the Banff Publishing Program at the Banff Centre. He's a past board member of Access Copyright and the Canadian Educational Resources Council, and is now President of the BPAA and Vice-President of the Association of Canadian Publishers. He's also the

co-author of two major studies on educational publishing in Canada, both available on line.
