The Writers Guild of Alberta and the Book Publishers Association of Alberta have once again recognized and celebrated the high level of writing and publishing in Alberta. At their annual awards Gala, held in Edmonton on the evening of Saturday, May 14, the two organizations presented 15 awards to authors and publishers.

The Honourable Gary Mar, Minister of Community Development, attended the Gala to present the Grant MacEwan Literary Awards, and to meet with many Alberta authors and publishers. The evening was emceed by CKUA's **Chris Allen**, who led more than 200 award sponsors, publishers, writers and guests from across Alberta in celebrating excellence in Alberta books.

Highlights of this year's awards:

- The University of Alberta Press was named Publisher of the Year, and also took home the Trade Non-Fiction Book award, for Edmonton In Our Own Words, and Book Design award for Damselflies of Alberta
- Calgary's Paul Anderson received the Georges Bugnet Award for Novel for his tour de force, Hunger's Brides
- University of Calgary Press received two awards: Scholarly Book for The Bar U & Canadian Ranching History, and Book Cover Design, for The Garden of Art.
- Walter Hildebrandt, Director of University of Calgary Press, received the Stephan G. Stephansson Award for Poetry for his own collection, Where the Land Gets Broken, published by Ekstasis Editions
- Edmonton journalist **Mark Lisac** is awarded the Wilfred Eggleston Award for Non-Fiction for his controversial **Alberta Politics Uncovered**, published by Edmonton's NeWest Press
