A card security code (CSC; also called card verification data [CVD], card verification number, card verification value [CVV], card verification value code, card verification code [CVC], verification code [V-code or V code], or signature panel code [SPC][1]) is a security feature for "card not present" payment card transactions instituted to reduce the incidence of credit card fraud.
