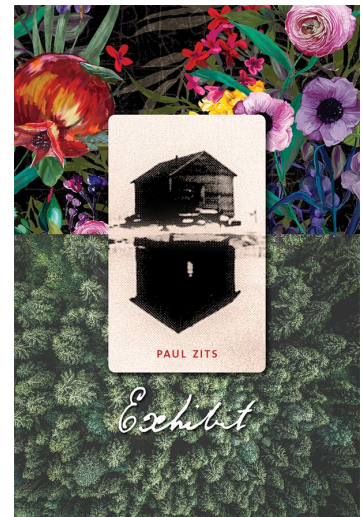

Paul Zits reaches into the archives to tell the forgotten true story of Margaret McPhail. Accused of murdering her brother in a small shack outside Drumheller, Alberta, she maintained her innocence throughout, claiming Alex died by suicide despite multiple bullet wounds to his head and chest. Full of gorgeous, unsettling imagery, *Exhibit* is a work of beautiful collage poetry, a piece of Alberta history, and a challenge to the ways we have learned to consume murder.
